Now an essential part of Appraisal & revalidation

- For all doctors
- Specifically for those whose primary or only task is medical management



Military Context

Leadership training within the military is currently responsibility of Defence Academy

- This provides a <u>potential</u> constraint to the development of medical leadership & management Trg within the DMS
- Action being taken:
 - Engagement with DA collaboration rather than alienation
 - Identify the requirement
 - Source the need

 - Medical student
 - Trainee
 - Consultant/Independent practitioner
 - Full-time medical manager
- Some generic some specific

- Proof of good medical practice with emphasis placed on reflection & development
- GMC supporting information requirements for revalidation
 - Continuing professional development
 - Quality improvement activity
 - Significant events
 - Feedback from colleagues
 - Feedback from patients (where applicable)
 - Review of complaints & compliments
