Who are they?

An international healthcare group, Bupa's stated purpose is helping people live longer, healthier, happier lives.

Bupa has 16.5 million health insurance customers, provides healthcare for 10.6 million people in their clinics and hospitals, and look after around 20,000 aged care residents.

Around 80,000 people are employed by Bupa, principally in Australia, the UK, Spain, Hong Kong, Chile, Brazil, Poland, New Zealand, Saudi Arabia, India and the USA.

With no shareholders, Bupa reinvest profits into providing better healthcare for the benefit of current and future customers.

What do they do?

In the UK, Bupa has around 60 wellness centres and health clinics, which offer services including health assessments, GP appointments, MSK treatments, mental health and cardiology services. Bupa is a major dental provider in the UK and Ireland with two million customers and around 450 clinics.

Bupa has announced that it has agreed to transfer some of its **care homes** to HC-One, a leading provider of health and social care, and a separate agreement has been announced with Advinia Health Care, subject to regulatory approval. Following this, Bupa will remain one of the biggest UK providers with around 130 homes and seven Richmond Villages.

The **Bupa Cromwell Hospital** is a complex care hospital in London providing care for insured, self-pay, NHS and international patients.
