## **About the Strategic Peer Support Programme**

The programme commences in January through to September 2015. Participants are encouraged to attend the virtual orientation session on the 28th January 2:00pm – 3:30pm and also the launch event at the FMLM conference in Manchester on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2015. The formal programme will commence following the launch event in February, and participants are required to attend three essential development days held on 18th March (London), 8th July (Leeds) and 16th September (Midlands/South) 2015. These days give the opportunity for the peer network to come together to learn, share and problem solve. Peers can expect to take part in a 6-8 peer support sessions (2-3 hours per session). These sessions may be held either face to face or virtually to meet the needs of the pairs.
